Scientific background and objectives

Understanding and addressing changes of marine systems and coastal environments demand increasingly interdisciplinary approaches and international collaborations. New scientific and technological developments in ocean sciences, and large international observation programs, have facilitated inter-disciplinarity and have also provided effective vehicles for international collaborations.

Following on the first ACOST Symposium held in Sydney and Canberra, Australia, 2005; the second held in Hainan, China, 2009; the third held in Sydney and Townsville, Australia, 2012; a fourth (ACOST4) is to be held in Qingdao, China, 2014. The purpose of the meeting will be to foster collaborations between Australian and Chinese institutions. ACOST4 will be held over three days, and will feature a mixture of presentations (delivered in either oral or poster format) from scientists of both nations. This symposium will promote and encourage exchange and collaboration in the Coastal Processes and Oceanography areas, including coastal sedimentation, engineering, biochemical, hydrodynamic processes, coastal observation systems and management.
